

Wee Care Childcare (WC) is a quality childcare program that provides a structured and nurturing environment. It is a flexible option that works with your schedule and you are only billed for the time that you use! Care is available Monday-Friday from 7:00AM to 9:00AM and 11:30AM to 5:30PM for \$6.00 per hour as space is available. This program is for children enrolled in our preschool aged children 30 months*-5 years. Final Wee Care placement is at the discretion of the Wee Care Manager.

*Students in our preschool's two's classes are permitted to use Wee Care prior to the age of 30 months.

Curriculum

Wee Care designs its curriculum to compliment and reinforce that of the preschool's. Each afternoon, we will provide at least one hour of free play to develop skills of self-regulation, problem-solving, sharing & negotiation and higher-level reasoning. Morning and afternoon snacks are provided with milk to drink*. Children bring their own lunches if staying during the lunchtime. Should an emergency occur and your child does not have a lunch, a lunch will be provided at a charge of \$5.50

A rest time is provided after lunch. Sleepers and children taking a quiet break will be separated.
